Part-time students are not eligible for annual payment discounts or multi-student discounts.

Juniors and Seniors (Dual-Enrollment and Study Hall)

We offer Dual-Enrollment through the College at Southeastern (CASE). The fee for that class is \$250 (paid directly to CASE). If a student is not enrolled in 2 or more classes at ECA, they are considered Part-time. For juniors and seniors that need to use the library as a Study Hall for other classes, there is a \$400 per period for the year.

Enrollment Fee

This fee covers administrative fees, FACTS/RenWeb accounts, ACCS/ACTS/VCPE memberships, student accident insurance, and other fees associated with student enrollment. If the enrollment packet is turned in and the fee is paid by **April 1st**, a \$50 discount per student will be applied.

Comprehensive Fee

This fee covers student's testing and curriculum costs. This fee should be paid by **June 1st** unless communicated to the Business Office that you want to roll it into your tuition plan.

STEAM Fee

This fee covers computer hardware and software updates and materials associated with science, art, and STEM classes. This fee should be paid by **June 1st** unless communicated to the Business Office that you want to roll it into your tuition plan.

Concentration Fee

This fee covers materials for all High School Concentration classes. This fee should be paid by **June 1st** unless communicated to the Business Office that you want to roll it into your tuition plan.

A 3% handling fee will be assessed to all credit/debit card payments for surcharges incurred. There is no fee to use an ACH (Automatic Clearing House) transfer for payments.

Available Discounts for Full-time Academy Students

Tuition Paid-in-Full (one payment) Discount

A 5% discount will be given if tuition is paid in full by **August 15th**

Multi-child Tuition Discount

Full tuition is charged for the eldest student

A 10% reduction is given for the 2nd eldest student enrolled

A 20% reduction is given for each additional student enrolled

Additional and Optional Costs

School Supplies

Students are expected to provide the supplies that will be needed for their individual class needs as well as some that will benefit the classroom as a whole. A list will be made available to families by the end of July. For Lower School families who would prefer not to gather their own school supplies, ECA will accept a \$30 supply fee per student and will purchase the supplies for your student(s). Please inform the office by **August 15th** if you want to have ECA purchase the supplies.

Lunches

Every week we offer lunches for purchase. On Wednesdays, we have Subway sandwiches. The cost of a 6" sub and chips is \$5. All proceeds go toward general fundraising. On most Fridays, we have pizza and on the last Friday of the month, we have Chick-Fil-A sandwiches. The cost of 2 slices of pizza / one CFA sandwich and chips is \$5. All proceeds go toward our Missions Fund.

Field Trips, Clubs, Sports, and Special Events

As a classical school, ECA highly values the hands-on learning opportunities provided by field trips. Throughout the year, there will be opportunities for students to attend field trips, participate in clubs and sports, and take part in special events. We attempt to keep costs to a minimum, but there will be additional charges for things like tickets and transportation.

Music Lessons

We offer various lessons throughout the school year. We will announce to our families when lessons are available.

The Learning Center

Part of what we offer at ECA includes programs for students who struggle academically or behaviorally. The Learning Center offers several programs which strengthen weak cognitive capabilities in any subject and can address various learning and processing dysfunctions. These therapies, offered at various price points, will enable students to become effective, confident, and self-directed learners for life. Many of our faculty members offer tutoring throughout the course of the year. Students do not need to be enrolled at ECA to benefit from this department.
