



2026-2027 Tuition and Fees

Listed below are annual rates and tuition. Fees are per student, non-refundable, and not prorated; students that enroll after the school year has started will receive prorated tuition. Fees are not prorated.

Annual Fees

Comprehensive Fee	\$200
Supply Fee	\$100

Application and enrollment fees are due when packets are submitted. The Application Fee supports administrative fees, as well as the use of our communication app, FACTS. The Enrollment Fee provides curriculum supplies and necessary resources for quality early education. The Comprehensive Fee covers the cost of curriculum and is due July 1st.

The Supply Fee covers classroom supplies and snacks.

Tuition is not adjusted to individual attendance or weather-related absences and closures. Part time students are not eligible for annual discounts or multi-student discounts.

Available Discounts for Full-time Academy Students

Tuition Paid-in-Full (one payment) Discount

A 5% discount will be given if tuition is paid in full by August 15th

Multi-child Tuition Discount

Full tuition is charged for the eldest student

A 10% reduction is given for the 2nd eldest student enrolled

A 20% reduction is given for each additional student enrolled
