We are so excited that you will be joining us at Camp Five:Five this summer! The name Camp Five:Five comes from Revelation 5:5, "Then one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed". We are looking forward to ten great weeks of academic camps this summer! Please complete this form to reserve your camper's spot as space is limited! Spaces will be first come, first serve.

Each week has a specific theme that will be explored in various ways each day. There will also be trips to the pool twice a week as well as the library.

**Structure of the Day:** Each camper's day will include:

- Start of day worship and Bible lesson
- Educational activities based around the weekly theme
- Field trips 2x/week, depending on age group (some of these outings may be a local park, zoo, laser tag, etc.)

Campers who are not currently registered at ECA or EKC will need to submit all enrollment forms, including a birth certificate and immunization record BEFORE their first day of camp. You will receive the needed paperwork after you complete this Registration Form. For campers currently registered at ECA or EKC, we will be in touch if additional forms or information are required.

We will be enrolling kids for the following class groupings, based on need:

Rising Kindergartners - Kinder Buddies

Rising 1st & 2nd graders - Rookies

Rising 3rd & 4th graders - Juniors

Rising 5th & 6th graders - Seniors

Rising 7th & 8th graders - Middle School Mania

### **Pricing:**

\$25 registration fee per camper (turned in with this form).

The weekly fee is \$150 when you register by April 16. If you register after April 16, the weekly fee becomes \$165. While we prefer for all students to be able to enjoy each full week of camp, in order to get the most comprehensive experience, we understand that some families are not looking for weekly care for their children and would prefer to select a per diem pricing structure. Daily Pricing is as follows (depending on when you register):

1 day: \$50 / \$55

2 days: \$95 / \$100

3 days: \$125 / \$130

4 days: \$140 / \$155

5 days (the best bargain!) : \$150 / \$165

Local field trips (pool, parks, library) are included in each week's fee. Additional field trips (laser tag, zoo, etc.) will be invoiced.

**Before/After Care:** Before and After Care is an option for families that need it. It is \$2.50 for each 30-minute segment.

**Schedule:** I understand that I am reserving the following days for my camper. If a change must occur, a notice of two weeks must be given by email to Owen Donnelly (odonnely.eca@gmail.com). If a two week's notice is not received, I understand that I will be responsible for payment of days registered for. For last-minute schedule changes, I understand that I must receive confirmation that a spot is available before dropping off.

## Weekly Camp Descriptions

While all camp themes are the same for each age group each week, the depth of information that will be experienced will be different based on the age group of your camper. Please read below to find descriptions for each week. Let us know if you have any questions!

### **World Explorers (Geo Camp):**

Buckle up, as we climb aboard to travel the world in our World Geography Camp! Campers will discover foreign lands, traditions, history, food, customs, music, art, etc... from all over the globe! Prepare to learn how other cultures live, think, and behave as we peer into their parts of the world! No passport needed to join in on the fun!

### **All About Animals:**

Does your camper LOVE to learn about animals? This is the camp for them! This week we will learn about various kinds of animals, feeding habits, care taking strategies, and more. We hope to have some furry friends join us in our learning adventures. This week's field trip may include a visit to a local zoo or horse farm, depending on availability and Covid restrictions.

### **Sports:**

Send your aspiring athletes to this camp, as we dive into loads of sports fun! We'll learn all about team sports, lessons about great athletes in history, the fundamentals of various sports, and even the science behind muscles. We'll have fun with physics, as we guess throwing and kicking trajectory and acceleration. For even more fun, send your camper in his or her favorite team-wear during this special sports week!

### **Under The Sea (Marine Biology Camp):**

Come learn all things 'Ocean' in our camp that focuses on how wonder-filled God made the sea and all things living within it! Explore ocean life, habitats, and creatures that will boggle your mind and stun your imagination!

### **Amazing Arts:**

Calling all crafters, writers, musicians, chefs, and artists! This fun week will be spent learning about many different kinds of arts, including performing, visual, culinary, and musical. We will spend time together this week learning about those in history who have made contributions in each area of art and will have fun making many of our own creations!

### **Space Camp:**

This camp speaks for itself. We will spend this week learning about all things having to do with SPACE! If your camper enjoys learning about defying gravity, the amazing planets, and life in space this is the camp for them! Older students may get to visit a planetarium for their field trip this week (all trips are dependent on Covid protocols and regulations at the time of planning).

### **Spy Week:**

Do you have a camper who loves to solve mysteries? This is the camp for them. We will dive into the world of famous spies in history and forensic science (even the youngest of learners get to learn about fingerprints and solving riddles using clues!). Have your camper put on their problem-solving cap and send them to Spy Week, where we'll learn to use our sleuthy powers for good!

### **Time Machine (History Camp):**

Let's travel back in time to observe those who formed the past! If your camper loves history, this is the camp for them. We will spend the week learning great stories from history, from all around the world. **Outdoor Survival:**

Calling all survivalists! This week we will learn how to survive in the wilderness, read a compass, camping basics, and all things 'outdoor'. This week will include a field trip to Camp Highroads, one of the most beloved outdoor adventure camps in our region!

For our final week of camp, we will dive into several great books, learn about the lives of the authors, and the time period in which the stories were written. We will also learn about what it takes to publish a book, as well as all the jobs that are included, from illustrating to writing to marketing and beyond.
