

2023-2024 School Supply List

There are some things that are used school-wide, so we are asking each family to donate those items. We would like **Lower School** students to bring in 3 tubs of Clorox wipes and 4 boxes of Kleenex. We would like **Upper School** students to bring in 12 Dry Erase markers (no fine tip) and 3 rolls of paper towels. Because storage is limited, we have staggered donation dates. Please have Lower School students bring them to their classrooms. Upper School students should bring their items to their Morning Roundtable classroom.

Families with a last name of P-Z, please bring your items the week of September 5-8 Families with a last name of A-H, please bring your items the week of November 13-17 Families with a last name of I-O, please bring your items the week of February 20-23

LOWER SCHOOL (K - 6th grade)

The homeroom teachers prefer to purchase needed supplies for their class. You will be invoiced \$40 per student to cover the cost of those items. You will need to provide your student with a backpack, lunch box/bag, and a water bottle. Please be sure they are labeled.

UPPER SCHOOL (7th - 12th grade)

Upper School students should be prepared with common items like pens and pencils. And help your student prepare for an organizational system that works best for them. Some ideas include a large binder with dividers (1 per class) and paper; 1 spiral notebook for each class, along with a folder for homework and papers; a 1" binder for each class.

<u>All students</u> should have a Bible (any version) for class. <u>Students in Algebra I and II</u> need to have a scientific calculator (this does NOT need to be a graphing calculator). <u>Students taking Latin</u> need to have 1" binder, a pack of 8 dividers, loose leaf paper or separate notebook for notes, and 5 packs of 3"x5" lined index cards. <u>Students taking Spanish</u> need to have a 3-ring binder, 3 dividers, and loose leaf paper.
